BY LAW AMENDMENTS
RESOLUTION FOR ARTICLE I – OFFICE AND PLACE OF BUSINESS
Resolution 2201**

WHEREAS: The Christian Church In Nebraska’s Regional Church Board has engaged in conversations for more than two years, exploring what it means to be the Regional Church today, and into the future; and

WHEREAS: The Christian Church In Nebraska’s Continuing Review Committee has worked diligently for more than one year to discern God’s call upon us as the Regional Church In Nebraska, and how to best re-imagine with God the structure that will best support our newly stated purpose: **“to engage in spiritual practices as we accompany one another and our neighbors so that we can instill, support, and sustain the vitality of the Local Churches in our Region”**; and

WHEREAS: The Christian Church In Nebraska meets every two years to consider resolutions in its Regional Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Christian Church In Nebraska, at its Regional Assembly’s Business Session held on November 5, 2022 at First Christian Church in Grand Island, adopt the Proposed Article I to its By Laws as attached to completely replace the Article I of its current By Laws.

PROPOSED ARTICLE I**

PROPOSED BY LAWS

Office and Place of Business (lines 10-16 of Current By Laws)

The Regional Church Office shall be a virtual office with primary residence linked to/tied to the Regional Minister's home at 2523 Winding Way in Lincoln NE 68506, and the homes of any and all other staff persons. The Regional Church Office will maintain a P.O. Box with the United States Postal Service (USPS) for any/all mail.

CURRENT BY LAWS

10 **ARTICLE I**

11 **THE OFFICE AND PLACE OF BUSINESS**

- 12 A. The principal office and place of business of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in
13 Nebraska shall be in Lincoln, Nebraska.
- 14 B. The principal office and place of business can be changed upon the recommendation
15 of the Board of Directors of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Nebraska,
16 hereinafter referred to as the Board and approval by the Regional Assembly.
