RESOLUTION FOR ARTICLE X - AMENDMENTS
Resolution 2210**

WHEREAS: The Christian Church In Nebraska’s Regional Church Board has engaged in conversations for more than two years, exploring what it means to be the Regional Church today, and into the future; and

WHEREAS: The Christian Church In Nebraska’s Continuing Review Committee has worked diligently for more than one year to discern God’s call upon us as the Regional Church In Nebraska, and how to best re-imagine with God the structure that will best support our newly stated purpose: **“to engage in spiritual practices as we accompany one another and our neighbors so that we can instill, support, and sustain the vitality of the Local Churches in our Region”**; and

WHEREAS: The Christian Church In Nebraska meets every two years to consider resolutions in its Regional Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Christian Church In Nebraska, at its Regional Assembly’s Business Session held on November 5, 2022 at First Christian Church in Grand Island, adopt the Proposed Article X to its By Laws as attached to completely replace the Article X of its current By Laws.

470 **ARTICLE X**
471 **AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS**

472 Amendment of these Bylaws may be made at any Regional Assembly by a two-thirds (2/3)
473 vote of the qualified representatives present and voting, provided that the proposed
474 amendment shall have been published in full in the official publication of the Christian Church
475 (Disciples of Christ) in Nebraska at least thirty (30) days prior to the Regional Assembly at which
476 action is to be taken, and, provided further, that the amendment shall have been mailed to
477 congregations, registered voting and alternate representatives. The amendment(s) shall be
478 posted at the Assembly.

PROPOSED LANGUAGE

Amendment of By Laws (lines 470-478)

Amendments to the By Laws are the responsibility of the Regional Church Board. The Center on the Regional Church will review and propose any amendments to the By Laws to the Regional Church Board. The Board will consider any proposed Amendments to the By Laws. If approved by 2/3 vote by the Regional Church Board, the approved changes will take effect until the next Regional Assembly.

Approved amendments to the By Laws by the Regional Church Board will be reviewed and either approved by 2/3 vote of the voting members present or rejected by the Regional Assembly at the next gathering of the Regional Assembly. If a By Law amendment is rejected by the Assembly, the Regional Church Board will either revert to previous version of the By Laws or propose another amendment to the By Laws.
